Certificate III in Early Childhood Education & Care - Traineeship Pathway

This qualification reflects the role of educators in early childhood education and care who work in regulated children's education and care services in Australia. They support children's wellbeing, and development in the context of an approved learning framework. Educators use a range of well-developed skills and knowledge using discretion and judgment when carrying out their work in the context of established policies and procedures. They may work independently or under the guidance of others, though in some contexts that guidance may not be on-site. This qualification is delivered via a traineeship pathway.

Traineeships are an excellent way to combine training with work, enabling you to have a job while you complete training towards a nationally recognised qualification.

A training session plan is developed which outlines how the program is delivered to the trainee. A copy of the training plan is also provided to the trainee's employer.

The successful completion of this qualification is a prerequisite for the Diploma of Early Childhood Education & Care.

REQUIREMENTS

Traineeships provide an opportunity to train and earn an income at the same time while working towards a nationally recognised qualification. Entry to this qualification is open to individuals who:

- * Someone employed within long day care centres, family day care, preschools, or kindergartens.
- * A reasonable level of English language proficiency, literacy and numeracy skills are needed to complete the course and the assessment activities. Students will need to successfully complete a Language, Literacy and Numeracy test.
- * The course requires competency in using a computer or tablet devices for research and completing online activities.
- * Students over 18 years must be able to produce a current Working With Children Check.

Half Price Fees

This qualification is directly aligned with priority industry areas where the jobs are today, and into the future. Your employer will need to contact an Australian Apprenticeship Support Network (AASN) provider. They will help with applications for incentives or allowances and is your first point of contact for any support needed.
